

How does “Swaddling Clothes” work?

From various donors, we assemble a collection of items associated with pregnancy and motherhood—maternity and baby clothes, diapers, formula, bottles, etc... Then, on the second Saturday of each month, Christ Our Savior hosts a “shopping day” where you can survey our collection and take whatever you need, up to a certain number of items. If any of the items you take can be re-donated to Swaddling Clothes when you are done with them, we ask that you do so to help those in need after you.

We also partner with a number of other organizations, providing you with referrals if you are seeking counseling, health care, employment, etc... And, of course, being a part of a Lutheran congregation, we are always ready to share pastoral care and a Gospel word with those who need them.

We are open the second Saturday of the month from 10-2.

Donations can be brought in while we are open, or please call to schedule a drop off time.

About Christ Our Savior

Christ Our Savior Lutheran Church began as a mission of the Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod in 1938, but it wasn’t until 1984 that the congregation officially organized. Since then, she has been the home for Missouri Synod Lutherans in Elbert County, and a few neighboring counties.

Christ Our Savior considers herself a Biblical, Confessional, Sacramental, and Liturgical congregation. The Bible—the 66 canonical books of the Old and New Testaments—are the chief source of the faith that she teaches. This teaching is found in the Book of Concord, also known as the Lutheran Confessions. The sacraments—Holy Baptism, Holy Absolution, and Holy Communion—are highly esteemed by her as the means by which God reaches down to give her members, His people, forgiveness of sins, life, and salvation, which were won by the shed blood of Jesus Christ, her Lord. And the vessel by which the grace of God is proclaimed in her is through the historic liturgy, by which she is connected to the church of the past and the church of the future, where this same song has been, is, and will be sung. These four, the Bible, the Confessions, the Sacraments, and the Liturgy, proclaim and give Jesus Christ, His death on the cross for the sins of the world, and His resurrection from the grave.

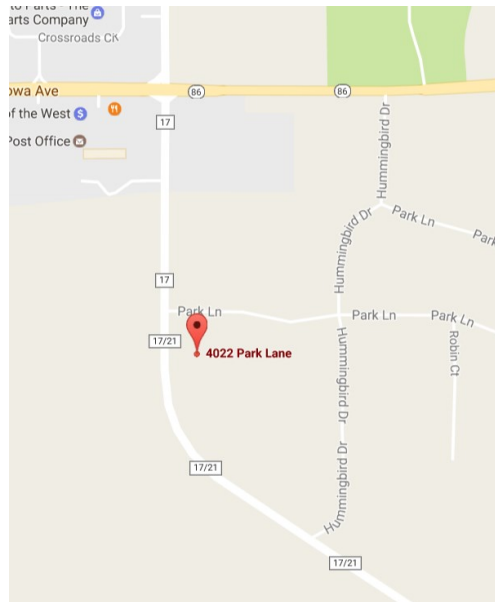
