

How does “Swaddling Clothes” work?

From various donors, we assemble a collection of items associated with pregnancy and motherhood—maternity and baby clothes, diapers, formula, bottles, etc... Then, on the second Saturday of each month, St. Michael hosts a “shopping day” where you can survey our collection and take whatever you need, up to a certain number of items. If any of the items you take can be re-donated to Swaddling Clothes when you are done with them, we ask that you do so to help those in need after you.

We also partner with a number of other organizations, providing you with referrals if you are seeking counseling, health care, employment, etc... And, of course, being a part of a Lutheran congregation, we are always ready to share pastoral care and a Gospel word with those who need them.

We are open the second Saturday of the month from 10-12.

Donations can be brought in while we are open, or call the church to schedule a drop off time.

The mission of Swaddling Clothes is to share the mercy of Christ with our neighbors through the gifts of clothing, food, friendship, and the forgiving Word of God.

About St. Michael

St. Michael's history begins in 1961. St. Michael was originally known as The Lutheran Church of West Wayne. The congregation chose to name the church St. Michael Lutheran Church. St. Michael is based on the Word of the Lord; it is used as a guide for people to follow and believe in. We also believe that we are saved by Grace, Faith, and Scripture alone. The Michigan District of Lutheran Church Missouri Synod extended a charter to St. Michael which increased our congregation number to 45 members. The original church building was built on September 15, 1963. As the congregation kept growing in size, the original building was not capable of holding all of the members in the church, so in 1977, expansion began. Program of Progress was created to help build the expansion (also known as St. Michael's current sanctuary). In 1974, St. Michael's educational system parted with St. Matthew and Nancy Banks was a teacher there. In 1980, St. Michael started a preschool and in 1982, Harv Schmit was the first principal and Nancy Banks moved over to St. Michael and has been a teacher and influential member at St. Michael ever since. St. Michael was fully expanded in 1980 and the sanctuary was renovated in 1981. In 1985, more classrooms were built because the congregation saw a need for more space. The church and school have gone through many renovations and has been refurbished in many ways to ensure that this place of worship is the best it can be: physically and spiritually.

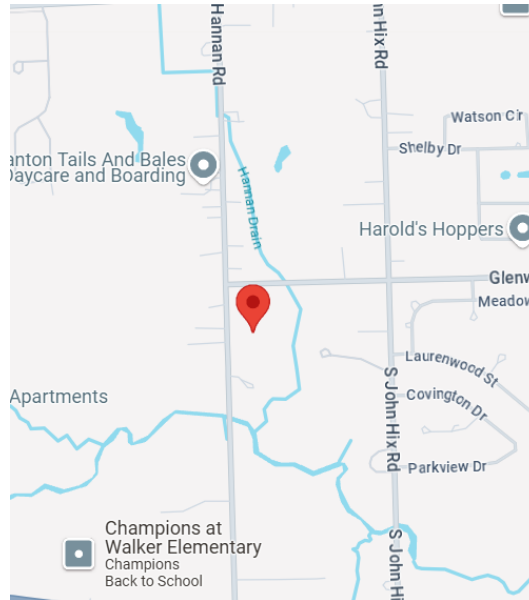
